 THE PROVISIONS ON CHILDREN'S SPORTS

CHILDREN'S RIGHTS IN SPORTS
 The Council of Europe's Human Rights Committee, in its 2002 Declaration on the Rights of the Child, states that children have the right to participate in sports and recreation, and that this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

1. RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE
 Children have the right to participate in sports and recreation, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

2. RIGHT TO BE HEARD
 Children have the right to be heard in matters relating to their rights, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

3. RIGHT TO PROTECTION
 Children have the right to be protected from all forms of violence, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

4. RIGHT TO A HIGH STANDARD OF LIVING
 Children have the right to a high standard of living, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

5. RIGHT TO EDUCATION
 Children have the right to education, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

6. RIGHT TO HEALTH CARE
 Children have the right to health care, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

7. RIGHT TO FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION
 Children have the right to freedom of expression, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

8. RIGHT TO FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT
 Children have the right to freedom of movement, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

9. RIGHT TO FREEDOM OF THOUGHT, CONSCIENCE AND RELIGION
 Children have the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion, and this right should be exercised in a way that is appropriate to their age and development.

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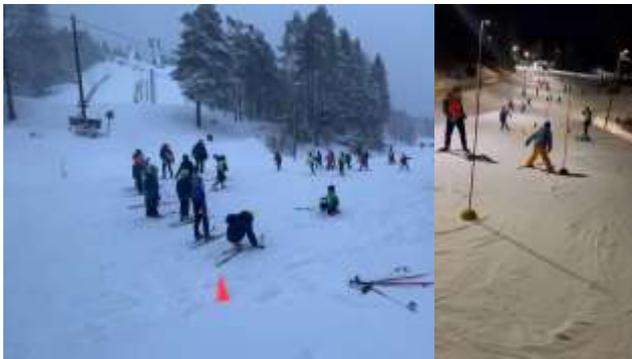
